



## Tuition, Reservation Deposit, Payment Plans & Tuition Refund Insurance

A \$500 non-refundable reservation deposit applied toward tuition is required upon enrollment. If enrolling after billing begins, tuition owed to date is required. Parents may elect to pay the tuition balance via any of the below payment plans. Tuition covers the balanced experience across ESJ's Four Pillars of Academics, Athletics, Fine Arts, and Spiritual Life, and also includes: technology, supplies and activity fees; standardized and developmental assessments; most grade level field trips; and Health, Safety and Well-Being programs. See below for additional expenses outside of tuition.

<sup>\*</sup>Tuition Refund Insurance (2.1% of 2023-2024 tuition) is optional and provides an opportunity to insure tuition (prepaid and due) in the event that a student withdraws after attending 14 consecutive days of school. All families are strongly encouraged to take advantage of this program to ensure some tuition dollars can be recouped if a student has to withdraw unexpectedly for any reason.

## Billing and Enrollment

- To be considered for re-enrollment or financial assistance for succeeding academic years, the account(s) of a student and all of his/her siblings enrolled at the school must be considered current and the student must be in good standing.
- All accounts are due and payable on the 1st of the month.
  Late fees are assessed after the 20th.
- If any payment is delinquent for 60 days following the due date, the student may be excluded from school attendance and activities.
- Incidental expenses are billed monthly, and tuition is billed according to the payment plan chosen. Parents/Guardians will select a Tuition Payment Plan and opt in or out of Tuition Refund Insurance via the enrollment agreement.
- · Payment online via My ESJ is preferred.

## Financial Aid

Need-based financial aid is available and, if awarded, is credited to the student's account in the same proportions as the tuition is billed. Financial aid applications must be submitted every year by the deadline indicated by the school. Receipt of, and the amount of, financial aid in one year does not guarantee that same amount or any assistance in the future. For more information, visit esi.org/tuition.

Afternoon extended care is available to families on an as-needed basis for an hourly rate.

- \$50 one-time registration fee
- \$10 per hour per child

### After 6:00 PM Late Fees:

- \$25 after 6:00 PM plus \$1 per each additional minute
  - Ex. If parent arrives at 6:10, the cost is \$35
